2013 ANNUAL CASE ANALYSIS

The total number of Internal Affairs Cases decreased this year, however, a comparison and statistical analysis shows that the six (6) year average case load is 12 cases. This past year's total cases are within 50% decrease of the six year average of cases investigated. We also experienced a decrease in the both the external and internal cases. One of the cases is being investigated by the line supervisor.

After reviewing cases investigated by the Internal Affairs Section, there does not appear to be a need to readdress any specific areas of policies and procedures.
