2012 ANNUAL CASE ANALYSIS

The total number of Internal Affairs Cases increased this year, however, a comparison and statistical analysis shows that the six (6) year average case load is 13.8 cases. This past year's total cases are within 1.5% of the six year average of cases investigated.

After reviewing cases investigated by the Internal Affairs Section, there does not appear to be a need to readdress any specific areas of policies and procedures.
