

## **City of Coral Gables Planning Department Staff Report**

**Subject:** **Zoning Code Text Amendment – Article 5, Division 14, “Parking, Loading, and Driveway Requirements”.** An Ordinance of the City Commission of Coral Gables, Florida amending the Official Zoning Code, Article 5, “Development Standards,” Division 14, “Parking, Loading, and Driveway Requirements,” Section 5-1404, “Materials, construction and drainage”, to clarify language used to cite for vehicles parked on unapproved surfaces; and, providing for severability, repealer, codification, and an effective date.

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### **Recommendation**

The Planning Department in association with the Building and Zoning Department recommends approval of the amendment to Zoning Code Article 5, “Development Standards,” Division 14, “Parking, Loading, and Driveway Requirements,” Section 5-1404, “Materials, construction and drainage”, to clarify language used to cite for vehicles parked on unapproved surfaces.

### **Background**

The Building and Zoning Department is proposing to amend the text of the Zoning Code to clarify the language used to cite vehicles parked on unapproved surfaces. The Zoning Code language is ambiguous and does not specifically state that vehicles cannot park on unapproved surfaces. The result is that tickets are being dismissed at code enforcement ticket hearings due to this issue.

The Building and Zoning Department has provided for the Board’s review and information a completed Zoning Code Text Amendment Request form (see Attachment A). A draft Ordinance containing specific language in ~~strike~~/underline format has been prepared for the proposed Zoning Code text amendment (see Attachment B). The Building and Zoning Department has also provided for the Board’s review photographic examples of vehicles parked on approved and unapproved surfaces (see Attachment C).

The Building and Zoning Department will present the proposed amendment to the Board at the meeting and will secure input and testimony from the Board and public.

**Public Hearing Timeline**

The proposed text amendment is tentatively scheduled to proceed forward for 1<sup>st</sup> Reading before the City Commission on October 26, 2010.
