The Segovia appeal will be decided on the record and transcript from the quasi-judicial hearing, which was a de novo hearing. The prior hearings were not quasi-judicial and were not the basis for the quasi-judicial decision that is being appealed. In contrast, the Granada case involved one quasi-judicial hearing that occurred on two separate days that resulted in the decision (the hearing was continued). In order to have a complete record for the appeal, both days of the transcript must be included.
